Dual fuel

If you can't choose between the simplicity of gas and the taste of charcoal cooking, try the **Char-Broil Gas2Coal BBQ** (£699.99, [amazon.co.uk](https://www.amazon.co.uk)). A hybrid that converts from gas to coal in seconds, this grilling giant means you can enjoy the smoky

flavour of coal or the ease of using gas.

The side burner is helpful for making and keeping sauces warm or sautéing vegetables.

Editor-in-Chief Katy says: 'This is one awesome bit of kit. Having the ability to use gas or coal gives you versatility, although do note that you need patio gas canisters, not ones designed for caravans, as we discovered! The canisters can be stored in the unit which has plenty of room below the cooking area. My husband really liked the inner shelf where you place food that's cooked (when you close the lid it stays raised from the coals). The BBQ needs self-assembly, which takes an afternoon, so order it a few days in advance of when you want to use it. The Amazon version doesn't come with a cover, so it's worth buying that separately to keep it protected from the British summer weather! All in all a fab bit of kit for serious BBQ fans.'

Digitally connected cooking

Transport your outdoor cooking into the 21st century with the revolutionary **Konnected Joe from Kamado Joe** (£1,999, directstoves.com). This WiFi-enabled 46cm ceramic grill takes the guesswork out of smoking, grilling, baking and more thanks to innovative digital controls. With the push of a button, the Automatic Firestarter ignites your charcoal while the Kontrol Fan maintains your target temperature.

Come rain or shine

The **George Foreman Indoor Outdoor BBQ Grill** (£94.49, amazon.co.uk) caters to your barbecuing needs all year round. Its versatile design allows you to grill indoors when it's raining, or outside when sunny. With its collapsible stand it can be used as a freestanding grill or placed directly on your countertop for a hassle-free grilling experience.



TOP TIP!

A BBQ doesn't have to be all about the meat – there's a whole world of other foods to be served up and enjoyed outdoors. From corn on the cob, griddled courgettes and vegetable skewers, to tofu, Quorn and grilled halloumi – there are plenty of non-meat options to pop on the grill.



Grilling on the go

Perfect for intimate dinners or grilling tasty treats on the decking, the charcoal **Feuerhand Tamber Table Top Grill** (£99.99, berryuseful.co.uk) is ready to use in around 15 minutes, has a heat-resistant lid that doubles as a trivet and comes in great colours. The enamelled, non-stick grilling grate is dishwasher-safe and designed so liquids drain away during cooking.

The **BODUM Picnic charcoal grill** (£99.90, bodum.com) is ideal for urban grilling, and easily transportable for spontaneous gatherings at the beach or park. Its compact size means it's easy to carry but large enough to cook four burgers or four small fillets simultaneously. Features include a cool-touch silicone handle, clips for easy transport, and removeable cooking rack.



Perfect for easy outdoor cooking – whether you're in the garden or away camping – the **Weber Lumin Compact Electric Grill Barbecue** (£359, gatesgardencentre.co.uk) features a whole host of clever functions, including modes to sear, smoke, steam, and boil your favourite foods. As this compact barbecue is electrically powered, you'll never run out of fuel – all you need is a power-point to cook for as long as you like. There is also less mess, waste, and smoke than other forms of barbecuing, and the flame-free design makes it safer and ideal to use in no-fire campsites.

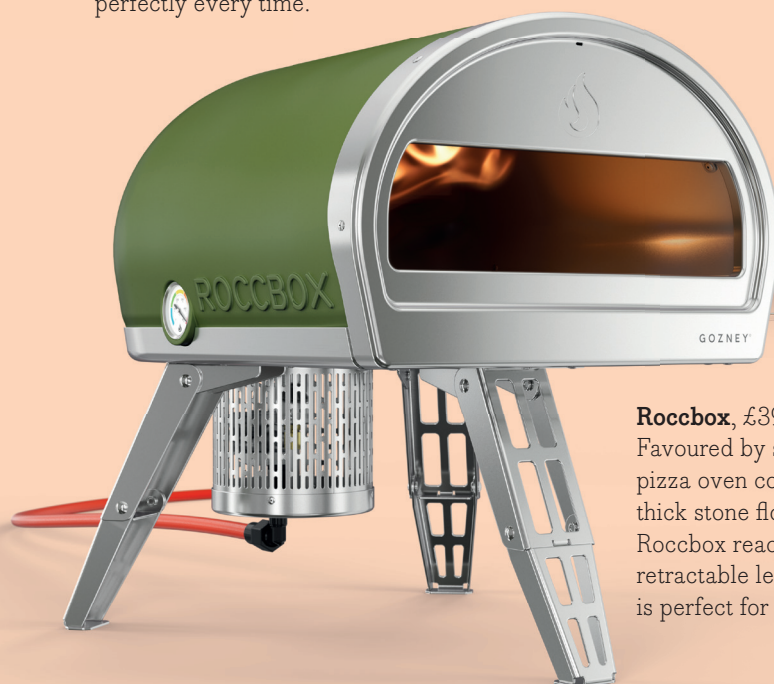


Arc (£599 and £699, gozney.com)
